- **The Fountain at Bessemer Court** operates mid-April through November with a state-of-the-art Waltzing Waters® Liquid Fireworks® Show. Hundreds of multi-colored water jets soar up to 40 feet in the air and are choreographed to music.
- **The Gateway Clipper Fleet** is America's premier excursion boat operation touring the three rivers year-round featuring dinner dances, sightseeing, specialty entertainment, one-day tours and charter cruises.
- **Just Ducky Tours** offers a fun-filled trip through Pittsburgh in a vintage World War II amphibious vehicle, able to drive from land into water.
- **The Duquesne and Monongahela Inclines** offer a panoramic view of the city of Pittsburgh from Mount Washington. The historic cable cars trek up the mountain from Station Square to incline museums and overlook platforms.
- **The Landing & Marina** at Station Square is a boater's dream come true. Open seasonally 7 days a week, boaters can access shopping, dining & entertainment from the shores of the Monongahela River.
- **Sheraton Station Square** is Pittsburgh's only waterfront hotel with dynamic views of the city skyline featuring 396 rooms in a newly-renovated facility.
- **Special Events** are happening every month at Station Square. Enjoy free concerts in the street each summer at Street Jam; have fun with your kids at our monthly Railway Rascals Kids Club events; celebrate the start of the Holiday season at Light Up Night or even ring in the New Year in "Times Square-Style" at Tick Tock Rock.
